Application Process

Legacy Fund Vision

The Legacy Fund supports the core mission of Bethel. Its primary use is to underwrite or subsidize special projects or initiatives which further that core mission. Programmatic initiatives are privileged, but neither capital projects nor support of the annual budget are prohibited. Projects or programs can be allocated funding for a one to three-year period, but normally will not receive on-going funding.

Application Process

The Legacy Fund Committee accepts new proposals at any time during the year and will assess the project on its merits for effectively and impactfully furthering the mission of Bethel. The committee will work with the submitting individual/group to ensure all questions regarding the proposal are answered and then determine if the project should be presented to Church Council for consideration.

Application Content

The application should contain the following pieces before it is submitted to the Legacy Fund Committee Chair.

- Principal contact of request
- Description of project
- How project aligns with Bethel's overall vision
- Rationale for application to Bethel Legacy Fund
- Timeline
- Amount of funds requested
- Description of how project will be evaluated
