

Projection Operator

Bethel is looking to build a team of 4 individuals who can help to set up and operate the projection software during worship services. This position gets a unique view of the worship service and is an important role in creating worship and connection moments for our Bethel Family. A team of 4 would allow for a commitment of around 1 Sunday per month, enough consistency to maintain skills and enough balance to keep the yoke light. Training will be provided. The goal is to always have 2 video technicians for each service, a Projection Operator, and Live Stream and Camera Operator.

Required Skills

- Willingness to learn and an open mind

Specific Tasks and Expectations

Preparation in advance of 9am on day of service: (15 – 30 minutes)

1. Import and organize all the items of service into the projection software (*via remote connection if working from home the day before**)
 - Hymns, Scripture, Images, Videos

Morning of a service: (2 – 2 ½ hours)

2. 9am arrival
3. Login to Projection system, turn on projector and TV
4. Check over order of service for any changes
5. Finalize hymn verses needed
6. Dry run of projection hymns and sound check for any videos with audio technicians
7. Operate projection software during the worship service
 - Advance hymn slides to follow along with worship songs
 - Advance scripture slides with reader
8. Collaborate with Live Stream and Camera Artist
9. Debrief and document any new learning
