CHARTING A NEW COURSE

If you are in need of financial advising and want BFA to work with you, the process is as follows:

➤ Approach a member of the pastoral team or one of the BFA members. From there you will be directed to BFA for guidance and two BFA committee members will be assigned to work directly with you.

➤ In your first meeting with members of BFA you will be informed as to how the committee functions. You will be advised of the need for full financial disclosure to the committee. This may include providing copies of income tax returns, net worth statements, recent pay slips, as well as credit card and bank statements.

➤ Your initial meetings with BFA will be exploratory in nature. They will include a needs assessment and survey available options. All BFA committee members are integrally involved in the assessment and the recommendations relating to the financial situation.

Please note that fees are not assessed or expected and confidentiality is maintained at all times.
